On March 25, the university will introduce OneUSG Connect to replace ADP. At that time, all employees will use OneUSG Connect for payroll and human resources transactions. They will be able to record and submit hours worked and absences, as well as view and update personal information, including direct deposit, pay stubs and benefits accessible from Employee Self Service in OneUSG Connect.
